

Chestnut Ridge Horseman's Club

Thank you for your interest in the Chestnut Ridge Horseman's Club. Our club grounds are situated in beautiful Bedford Co. near Pleasantville, Pa. We look forward to sharing our facilities and riding trails with you during the 2019 season of trail riding. Our club grounds offer wooded and open field camping sites with full restroom facilities including hot showers. We offer optional electrical hookups for campers (\$5.00 per night hookup fee). All guests must furnish their own supplies and food for their horses.

Our club grounds can be located from the Bedford exit of the PA. Turnpike by turning left onto Old Route 220. Go four-tenths of a mile and turn left onto interstate 1-99 North. Exit at the Cessna exit (Approximately 3 miles). Follow Route 56 West to Pleasantville (Approx. 8 miles) and at the light in Pleasantville continue straight through 1.9 miles still on Route 56 West (Watch for trail ride signs) till you need to turn right after crossing the second small cement bridge, onto Calvary Hollow Road. (It is the road to Lovely). Go 2.6 miles till you come to the club grounds on the left. If you are traveling East on Route 56 from the Windber area, turn left onto the first macadam road at the foot of the mountain, (Calvary Hollow Road). Watch for trail ride signs.

All trail rides leaving from the club grounds will be led by a trail boss. A different route is taken each day to allow you to enjoy the many different trails. We offer a variety of rides to assure everyone's riding pleasure.

Everyone must come to the clubhouse upon arrival and register. All individuals who ride will be required to pay the appropriate trail ride fees regardless if meals are consumed or not. There is no telephone service at the club grounds. Cell phones will be available if anyone needs to call out in an emergency.

Anyone under 18 years of age must be supervised by an adult over 21 years of age at all times.

The club grounds will open at noon on Thursday and the club will provide a light meal from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. Friday and Saturday; Breakfast is served between 7:00 -7:45 am. There will be lunch items available at this time for you to pack for your trail lunch. Supper is at 5:30pm.

The long ride leaves at around 9:00am and returns around 3:00pm. The short ride leaves at 9:30am and returns around 1:30 pm. Saturday the entertainment will be provided by a DJ from 8:00- 11:00pm.

Note: There will be a tack auction (new/used) on Friday after supper at our fall ride. Anyone wishing to donate anything to this auction please bring it to the clubhouse anytime during the rides.

Sunday: Worship service at 7:00am. Breakfast served from 7:30-8:30 am .The trail ride departs at 9:30am and returns around 1:30pm. Lunch is served when the ride returns before 2:00pm.

The Silver Stirrup Tack shop will be present for all your new or forgotten needs.

Rules

Public drunkenness will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave. (No refunds)

No alcoholic beverages allowed while riding

No littering on the trails

If your horse kicks you must tie a ribbon on its tail.

Meal tickets are not transferable.

Your camp must be quiet by 12:00, No loud generators.

Do not let horses chew the trees.

Bathing horses is not permitted at the watering sites.

No riding after 8:00 pm.

No running your horse on club grounds.

No Stallions.

Please fill your water tanks at the white tank at the top of the hill.

All dogs must be cleaned up after and on a leash at all times.

No dogs aloud on the trails.

Children 12 and under must wear a safety helmet when riding.

Camping Information and Fees

The trail ride is limited to 110 riders. No walk-ins . You must be pre-registered to attend the trail rides. Cost is \$75.00 for the ride for adults over 18 (7-17 is half price and under 7 is free)

Visitor meal is \$8.00 (under 7 is free)

Optional electrical hookup fee if wanted is \$5.00 per night.
